- Main Street Wellington MSW Director Arnz thanked resident for their donations to Connect to a Cause where they received \$1,807.00 in donations. She reported on the Ghost Tour, the CBD Flower Pot Contest, and mentioned Support Local Saturday, and the Wondering Witches of Wellington event. She
