DRINKING WATER NOTICE

Monitoring requirements not met for Wellington Village PWS

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During the January – June 2022 monitoring period we did not monitor for all the required lead and copper samples and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time.

What Should I Do?

This notice is to inform you that Wellington Village PWS did not monitor and report results for all the required lead and copper samples during the January – June 2022 monitoring period, as required by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency. The PWS took 39 lead and copper samples when 40 samples were required. You do not need to take any actions in response to this notice.

What Is Being Done?

Wellington Village PWS currently monitors for lead and copper every six months until it is determined by Ohio EPA that the system can return to annual sampling. The water supplier will take steps to ensure that adequate monitoring will be performed in the future.
