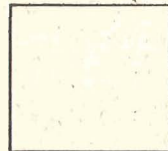

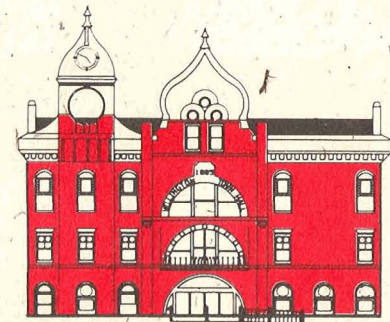

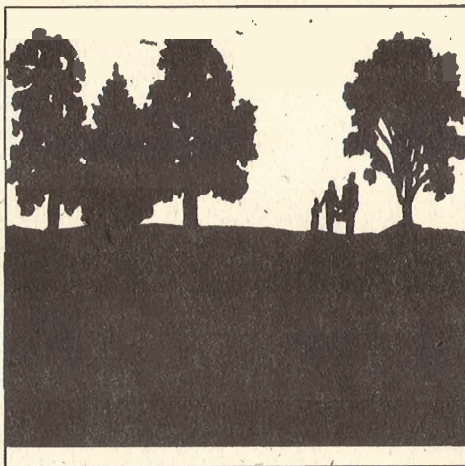
VILLAGE OF WELLINGTON SIDEWALK REPLACEMENT PROGRAM



VILLAGE SIDEWALK PROGRAM

The Village of Wellington is fortunate to have a comprehensive network of sidewalks, streets and drive aprons for the use of pedestrians and vehicles within the Village. However, the strongest paved surfaces wear out in time and should be replaced.

Due to the force of time and nature, some of our Village sidewalks have fallen into disrepair creating several big problems for our residents. The potentials of pedestrian injuries exist due to tripping on uneven or broken sidewalks. Our first concern must always be to the safety of our residents



and a comprehensive sidewalk program will respectfully provide a safer sidewalk for travel.

Concrete driveway approaches are also important to the residents, not only for entering and exiting their homes and businesses, but for keeping driveway stone and debris from entering our storm sewer system through catch basins.

Addressing the upkeep of our property, in particular, and of our neighborhoods, in general, is vital to the future of Wellington. Not only will our town be made safer by eliminating uneven, cracked or broken sidewalks, but improvements to the physical condition and aesthetics of our neighborhoods will be enhanced and preserve the value of housing and desirability of our Village.

I hope the following program description and guidelines will prove helpful in our sidewalk program.

SIDEWALK REPLACEMENT POLICY

Property owner must submit a written request for replacement to the Village Clerk. A cost will be given and payment to be made in thirty days after completion. The Village will remove existing materials and provide a rough grade. The Village will then perform or contract the forming and placement of new concrete, in which the Village will share the cost of labor and material at a rate of fifty percent. The Village will do the minor landscaping. This applies to residential and commercial property owners. The Village will repair any curbing and key areas where walk extends to the street. The Village will do engineering at Council and Mayor's request.

Driveway aprons and curb cuts are at property owners expense. This applies only to sidewalks in street right-of-way.
